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Manual FSDS

To avoid unnecessary delay in approval and procurement of your product, a guide for completing the FSDS has been prepared. We ask you to check the FSDS on the points below for each section before submitting it for LPC (supplier-product combination) application.

Section 1:

Clearly indicate your company information (GMP+/QS/Ovocom number), contact person and approval number if applicable, and whether you trade or produce this product.

Section 2:

Check whether the product identity and origin are clear.

- Feed material: GMP+ product code and EU feed material catalogue code
- Feed additive: EU feed register code
- Mixture: compound feed, mineral feed or premixture (substantiate with label)
- Production location: country (EU/non-EU) + certification (e.g. GMP+, QS).
- When purchasing under gatekeepers' principle, indicate the applicable gatekeeper protocol (including chosen options).
- State country of cultivation (plant products)/ slaughter (animal products)/ mining (mineral products) and approval number of the production site when applicable.

Section 3:

Ensure the characteristics of the product and the production process are clear:

- Describe the production process (the relevant version and page of the GMP+ risk assessment can be referenced when applicable).
- Make sure the production process is clear and all ingredients (feed material catalogue, GMP+ product code, EU feed register code) are clearly identifiably named.
- If products are subject to [SPV conditions](#) or the [Aflatoxin Protocol](#), this should be reflected in section 6/7/8.
- Do not forget excipients in the production process. When excipients are not included in the GMP+ risk assessment, inform GMP+ about this and attach the mail to GMP+ to the FSDS.
- State the dry matter content of the product, and its characteristics (crude ash, crude fat, crude protein, crude fibre) or relevant levels of active compound (in the case of additives)

Section 4:

- State all contaminants listed in the [SecureFeed risk classification](#) for this specific product.
- State the target animals are farm animals and indicate the intended use (direct delivery to farmers and/or processing in compound feed).
- Give advice of usage if relevant regarding contaminants or additives present (e.g. usual and maximum incorporation into compound feed/rations and/or exclusion of certain target animals).

Section 5:

- Attach the label separately when necessary.

Section 6:

- State at least all contaminants listed in the [SecureFeed risk classification](#) for this specific product.
- State for each contaminant; a justification for the control measures per ingredient (e.g. cultivation declaration pesticides, absence declaration fumigants/GMO, monitoring supplier according to QS/GMP+/BFA, positive release on ingredient X).

Section 7:

- For each contaminant; describe the sampling location and the frequency of monitoring (e.g. every Incoming or outgoing batch, 4 times a year, every 10th batch, per 100 tons, according to GMP+ formula, etc.) and whether this is a rapid test or accredited method.
